INSPIRATION FOR OUTREACH

Luke 10:18-19 *"And he said to them, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you."* The heavenly servants of God preserve His human messengers on earth, the ministers of "the blood of the Lamb," against all the power of the enemy, for by "the word of their testimony," the Church is saved and the devil is defeated.

INSPIRATION FOR STEWARDSHIP

Luke 10:20 *"Nevertheless, do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven."* God has a record of his people, and they can be certain that they will not be eternally lost. This is confirmed by Christ in the New Testament. It is the same as the Lamb's "book of life," which plays an important role in Revelation. Through Holy Baptism and faith in Christ as the Lamb who was slain for the forgiveness of sins (Rev 5:6, 12; 13:8), a person's name is written in this book. Jesus promises that the name of everyone who "conquers/is victorious" will remain written in his "book of life" (Rev 3:5), and God gives us the resurrection "victory" in Jesus Christ (1 Cor 15:57), and our "victory" over the world is through perseverance in "faith." (1 Jn 5:4).
