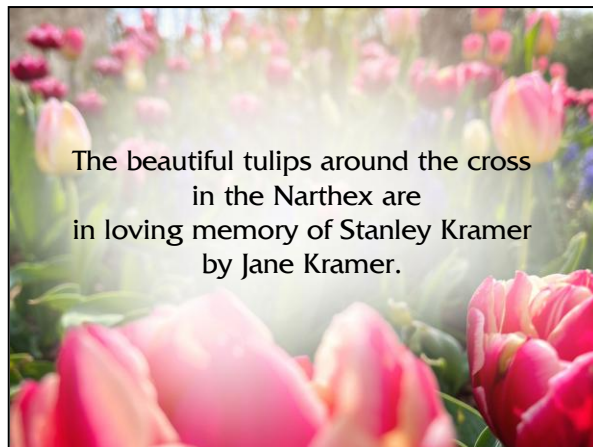
SERVICE OF PRAYER AND HEALING ON HIATUS
